YEAR -1

(Notes: Examination will be conducted based on 50% marks for Written and 50% marks for Oral + Practical. All course materials related to the questions are mostly covered in Sangeetangan class textbooks. Teachers and students will have the flexibility to teach, learn and answer beyond the class text books. For Oral and practical examination, an External Examiner – a prominent classical vocal teacher from other institution will be invited.)

- 3. How to write down the notations of "komol Swaras", "Sudha Swaras" and "Teevra Swara"?
- 4. What is "Swara", "Shruthi" and "Pitch"?
- 5. What is meant by "SAPTAK"? How many "SAPTAKS" are used in Harmonium scales? Identify the three SAPTAK position in Harmonium.
- 6. How many basic "Musical Notes" or "Shrutis" within a Saptak?
- 7. What is meant by "Arohana /Avarohana notes" in Saptak? Show a segment of "Arohana /Avarohana notes" for all "Sudha Swaras".
- 8. What are "Paltas" or "Basic Alankars"?
- 9. What are "Sargam Taans" and "Akar Taans"?
- 10. Perform few simple "Paltas" in "Sargam Taan" and "Akar Taan".

- 6. Explain the meaning of "BANDISE" and it's six parts.
- 7. Explain the origin of "Harmonium"? How does it work? Explain types of Harmonium based on number of keys and couplings type.
- 8. How to operate the Harmonium safely and maintain in good condition?
- 9. What is "Taal"? Mention types of Taal in terms of beats per minute.
- 10. Explain the rhythm Textures of "Taal", "Theka", "Taali" and "khaali".
- 11. Write the "Bols" of "Ektal", "Teen Taal" and "Jhaptal".
- 12. What is "Thaat"? Describe "Thaat Classification" in Classical Music.
- 13. Explain characteristics of Ten Thaats.
- 14. What is Raaga? Write two well-known Raagas in each Thaat. Why the "Raaga time" of performance is important for Each Raaga?
